Call to Order: Meeting called to order at 6:40 p.m. via Zoom.

DISCUSSION AND ACTION ITEMS

Check In: Attendees participated in a Two Word Check In Activity that was developed by author, public speaker, and leadership developer Brene Brown.

May Minutes: Motion made by Cynthia Coleman to accept Minutes of May Vestry Meeting..Supported by Eddy Fulton. *Motion carried unanimously.*

Diocesan Training Session: Alice proposed several dates for the Vestry to be trained by the Rev. Canon Ellen Ekevag. The goal of the leadership training is to make Trinity a more faithful, healthy and effective church. Those dates are Saturday, September 10th from 9 am-12 pm, Saturday, September 17 from 9 am to 12 pm, and Sunday, September 18th from 11 am to 2 pm. Vestry members are asked to provide dates that will work for them. Clarification of training was requested and it was related that training will begin with Vestry and leadership and filter down to the congregation as a whole. No vote taken at this time.

REPORTS AND UPDATES

Discernment Groups Update

Last month the Discernment group stated the agreed upon goals were to improve our relationships and communication among all members of our Trinity church congregation and to reach out and build relationships in the community. We sought help from the Diocese and are receiving Leadership training as described above, and are seeking to provide a community meal once a month. This will

require a minimum of 10 volunteers to help with this and we are hoping to begin this outreach in the fall.

Building and Grounds Update

Eddy reported no current issues. Lawn cutting is going well. The Lawn has received Weed and Feed once already. Erica and Eddy killed the weeds on the sidewalks and in the flower beds. The Boy Scouts helped to clean out the ditches. Eddy received an estimate of \$372 for top soil and mulch. Eddy attempted to contact the stained glass lady with no luck. Additional phone numbers were provided. Eddy is also looking into obtaining solar reflective film for the east side to keep the heat of the sun out and is looking to get estimates for concrete repair.

Treasurer/Finance Team

Cyndi reports that we are on track for revenue this month. Pledges are slightly ahead with 43% in at the 42% mark of the year. Expenditures are less than budgeted. The deficit is \$10,000 year to date. Cyndi is looking to get a chart to serve as a visual aid for budget status. The Special Events team would like to secure a line item on the formal budget for their budgeting purposes.

LakeFest

Deb reports that for Lakefest this year, the booths will be set up on Main Street, not on the lakeshore as previously thought.

Priest's Report

Rev. Alice reported that Kathy Graham has resigned from the Altar Guild. Erica Fulton is now the current directress.
